## ***Suriname, SubZonal 2.3.5 Championships Female,***

***1 - 7 February 2014***

### ***General Conditions***

The Championships will be played according to the FIDE Rules of Chess, the “REGULATIONS FOR THE SUBZONALS” and the following General Conditions.

1. Open to all players from Subzone 2.3.5 who have a FIDE rating.
2. Each National Chess Federation can register any number of rated players. All players must provide the authorization of their Federation.
3. The participating category is : Female
4. The Game will be a Swiss System of nine (9) rounds or Round Robin depending on the number of players and at the discretion of the Chief Arbiter.
5. The rhythm of play will be ninety (90) minutes for all the moves plus an increment of thirty (30) seconds per move from the initial move. The tournament will be Internationally Rated and will be reported to FIDE.

## **6. Winners:**

The final placing will be decided based on the points obtained by each player, who obtains the most points will be declared the Champion. In case of ties the winners will be decided by the strict implementation of the following tiebreak systems in the order mentioned:

### Tie break system Swiss tournament:

1. – Direct encounter
2. - Buchholz
3. – Sonnenborn Berger
4. – Most wins
5. – Most wins with black

### Tie break system for round robin tournament:

1. Direct encounter
2. Sonnenborn Berger
3. Koya System
4. Most wins
5. Most wins with black

## 8. **Discipline:**

a. The Championships Organizers expects the highest standards of behavior and fair play by the participants.

b. Tolerance: The player who has not made a move thirty minutes after the official start of the rounds shall loose his game.

## 9. **Individual Prizes:**

The first five (5) places shall be awarded the following prizes:

1st Place U\$ 1000

2nd U\$ 850

3th U\$ 750

4<sup>th</sup> U\$ 650

5th U\$ 500

## 10. **Titles Awarded and Rights:**

Titles and norms will be awarded according to Fide regulations

## 12. Participants Costs:

### 1. Recognition:

The Organization will recognize the accommodation and meals for the previous edition Champion and also the Zonal Champion, additionally will also cover one official player from each federation belonging to the Sub Zone.

### 2. Registration:

All players without exception must pay the CCA registration fees USD 75.00 (seventy five American dollars) and USD 25.00 (twenty five American dollars) for the Organizers. This Fee must be paid in cash on site or before. Players who do not pay at the beginning of the tournament cannot be paired.

Participants who register after 29 January 2014 will be penalized by paying an extra USD100.00 late registration fee, the objective is to guarantee hotel Reservations for the participants and accompanying persons.

### 3. Credential:

For all participants and accompanying persons in the championship, the credential (ID) will cost USD 5.00 (five American dollars).

### 4. Pre - Registration:

The Pre-Registration of the participants must be made by their Federation

### 5. Formalization of Registrations:

a. The Pre-registrations must be made by each Federation by email with all details of the participants: Names, FIDE Title, FIDE Code, FIDE Elo, Date of birth and Fed name, before January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014 to the following email address: [surichess@yahoo.com](mailto:surichess@yahoo.com) or via the on-line registration at [www.surichess.com](http://www.surichess.com)

b. Each player must show their original passport or ID and deliver a photocopy of the same.

c. The Organization will only accept registrations sent by their respective Federations.

d. The on-line registrations will close January 29th, 2014, at 00:00 hours

#### 6. Pairings & Archives:

Before the beginning of the First Round of the Championships, a list with all the names of participants will be published at the playing hall. The Pairings will be published at least two hours after the last game of each round at the tournament's Official webpage or chess results and at the venue's hall.

#### 13. Official hotel:

Official players representing their federations will be accommodated in Hotel Wyndham Garden. It's recommended for other players and officials to also stay in Hotel Wyndham Garden. Prices are per person and all inclusive 3 meals from dinner on the 30th January to breakfast on 09 February 2014.
